

**COVID 19 CONTROL ARRANGEMENTS FOR STEP 2****CHELTENHAM SPA****BOWLING CLUB**

The normal advice not to visit the Club if players are experiencing any Covid 19 symptoms or Flu like symptoms is a precursor to these arrangements.

Separate detailed advice sheets will compliment these arrangements with playing advice from Bowls England and will be available on the Club website and printed copies displayed by the club main access area away from the entrance door.

	Access to the Club Lounge limited to duty staff	Refreshments provided only available by service in line with outdoor hospitality guidelines.	Additional Catering staff required for outdoor hospitality service.	Any outdoor socialising limited to groups of 6 while maintaining social distancing.

**2.CONTACT WITH POSSIBLY CONTAMINATED EQUIPMENT OR SHARED BUILDING TOUCH POINTS**

Identify potential areas that may be contaminated when club is in use

Teams for away matches not to include car sharing

Players to sanitise hands on arrival at Club. Cleaning routine to include sanitisation of doors and gate handles, locks, push plates, seating and window cills etc and any shared equipment

Bowling equipment available limited to include mat, jack, rink markers, scorecard and any bowling aids as required for play. Use in accordance with NGB and Club guidance.

Advise our players of other clubs controls for away matches where known.

Provide hand sanitizer at key points and equipment spray for use prior to and after play where needed. Hand sanitiser provided on green surrounds for use where equipment is shared

Display advice posters at appropriate area and display guidance information on site and on Club web pages.

Doors and gates held in open position to avoid contact where appropriate.

Adhere to other Clubs covid advice when playing in away matches

Use sanitiser on entering and leaving club and after using toilets after washing hands. Leave toilets in clean state.

Familiarise themselves with this guidance.

Retain all scorecards with players names. Retain record of rink bookings.
